

WAITLIST ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM

Waitlist Requirements

Service members will not be placed on the waitlist until they provide a completed application, a copy of their orders, a signed Restricted Pet Breed Acknowledgement Form, and a signed copy of this form.

Waitlist Priorities

Regardless of branch of service, service members with an assignment to Langley AFB are considered target tenants and have priority on housing offers/assignments above all others. The only exception to this are members assigned to Langley AFB who are considered Key and Essential and/or members with Exceptional Family Members who have provided supporting medical documentation that warrants priority housing assignment. All other service members who are not specifically assigned to Langley AFB will only be offered a home once the waitlist has been exhausted for service members who are assigned to Langley AFB.

Waitlist Preferences

There is only one wait list which is based on availability at the time the service member is eligible for an offer. There is no distinction on the waitlist between the type and/or the location of a home. While we will try to meet preferences we are unable to guarantee which housing area will be available at the time an applicant is eligible for an offer from the waitlist. We are unable to hold off on offering homes to meet preferences.

Waitlist Process for Home Assignment

Once the service member is placed on the waitlist and availability permits, a Resident Relocation Specialist will contact you with an offer for home assignment. The contact efforts will include contact information provided on the application, should that contact information change it is the responsibility of the applicant to provide up to date contact information.

Once contact is initiated, a service member will have 48 hours to respond back to the Resident Relocation Specialist. If there is no response the service member will be removed from the waitlist. If the service member would like to consider options, they will have an additional 24 hours to make a decision on the offer. If the service member declines the initial offer and another home is available a second offer will be made immediately with an additional 24 hours to make a decision on that offer. If a second home is not available the second offer will not occur until a home becomes available. Should the second offer be declined, regardless of reason, the service member will be placed at the bottom of the waitlist and wait until all other service members with priority on the waitlist are offered homes prior to additional offers being made. Service members must decline all offers in writing.

Waitlist and Promotions

If a service member is selected for promotion with an approved line number at the time of application, they will be eligible for the housing options of the promotable grade. If a service member is selected for promotion while waiting on a wait list, the service member will be positioned on the appropriate wait list as of the date that documentation was received to support it.

Site Unseen

If the home is not available to view when offered due to new construction or occupancy of the home, floor plans and location can be provided.
