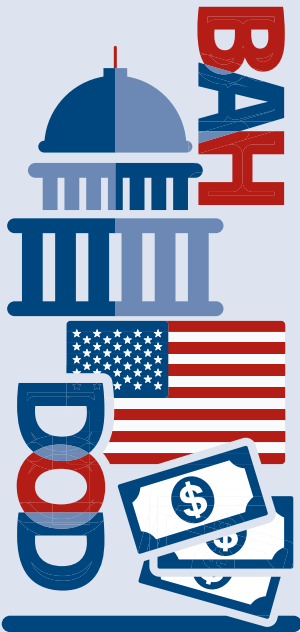

WHERE DOES YOUR BAH WITH HUNT MILITARY COMMUNITIES GO?

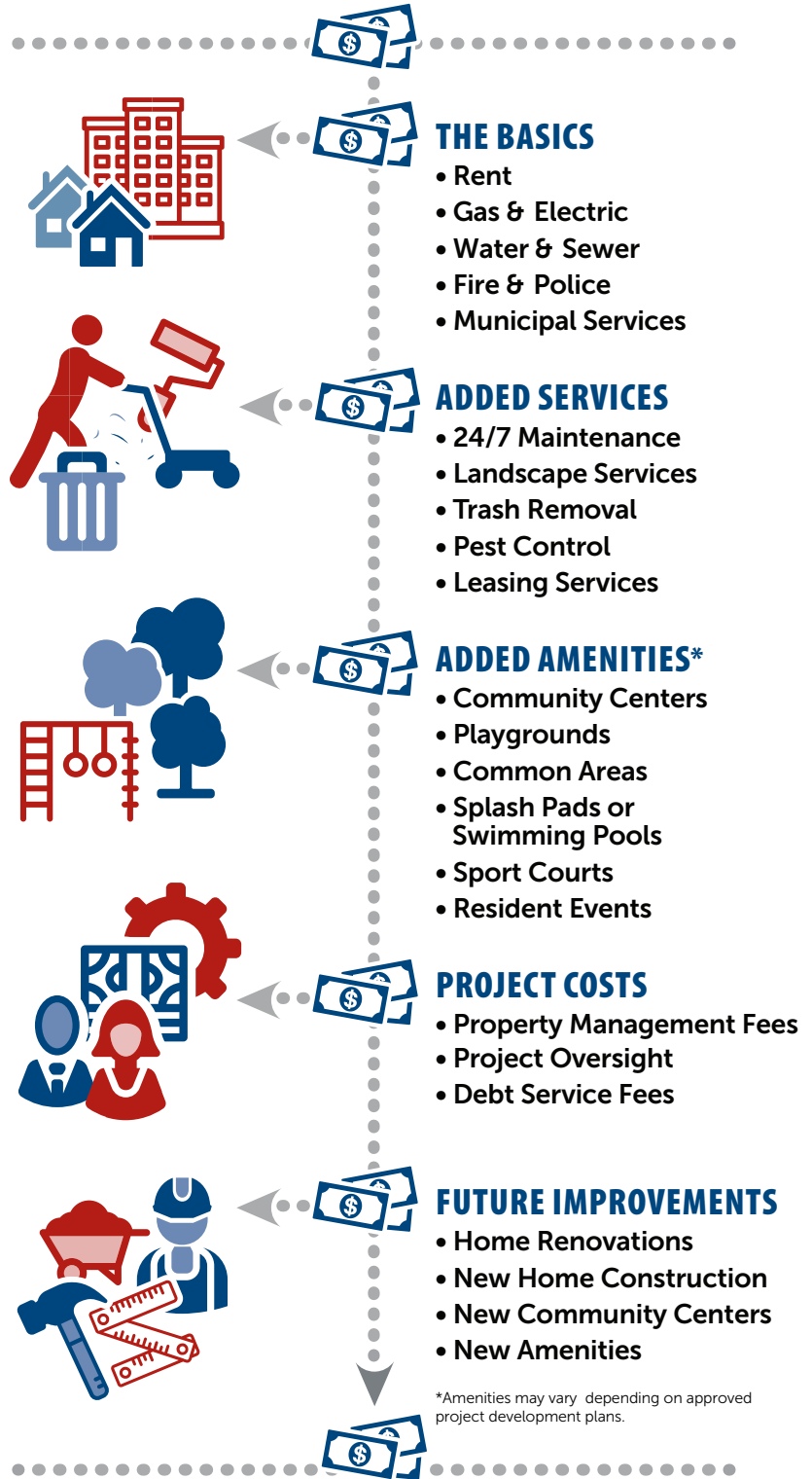


Your Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) is the stipend the Department of Defense allocates for you to pay for the majority of rent and utilities.
