WASTE MANAGEMENT & CONTACT INFORMATION

WASTE MANAGEMENT BULK COLLECTION PROCESS

1. Please consider item donation before placing out for bulk collection.
2. Place bulk items behind the curb line in front of your home no later than 5:00 PM before service day.
3. Do not place in the street, on the sidewalk, or in any fashion that may interrupt daily movement.
4. Do not place within 3 ft. of obstructions (mailbox, parked car, fire hydrant, tree, etc.).
5. Do not place under low hanging tree limbs or other overhead obstacles.
6. Residents also have the option to deliver bulk items directly to WM Bethel Landfill with proper ID.
7. Residents may place up to 2 cubic yards of bulk at the curb, per service.

Items that **WILL NOT** be accepted:

- Construction Materials
- Propane Tanks
- Carpet
- Cabinets
- Doors
- Sinks
- Toilets
- Glass
- Hazardous Waste
- Tires
- Dirt/Rocks/Concrete
- Vehicle/Motorcycle Parts
- Computers/E-Waste
- Paint
- Appliance
- Bagged Trash
- Items Small Enough to Fit in Curbside Container

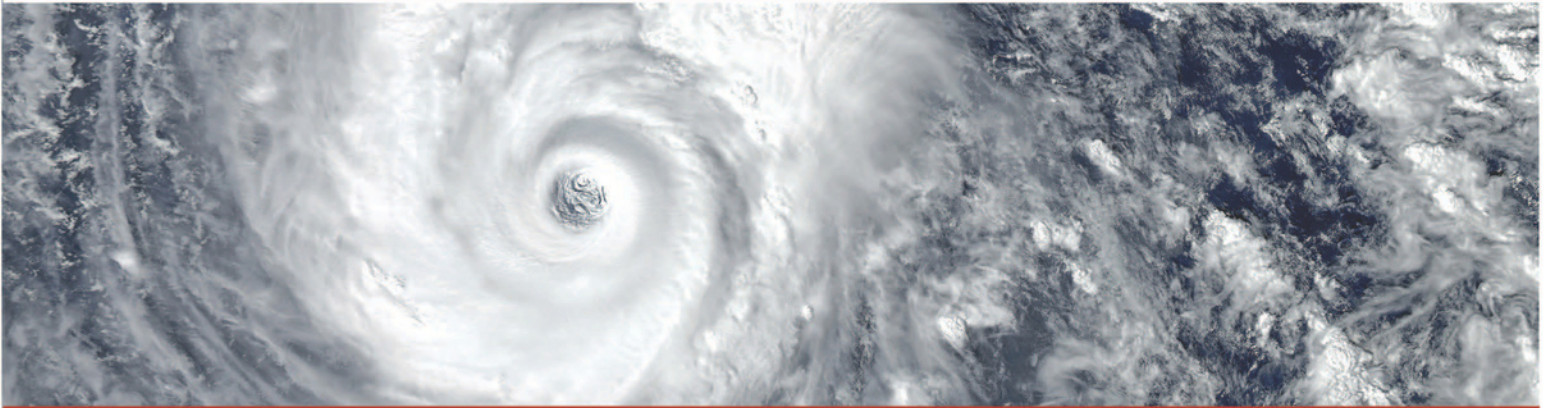

BE PREPARED!

Hurricane season is right around the corner. If you find yourself in the *possible* path of a hurricane, protect yourself and your family by preparing *early*.



Eastern Pacific Hurricane Season
May 15 - November 30

Atlantic & Central Pacific Hurricane Season
June 1 - November 30

Prepare an Emergency Supply Kit including:

- Copies of prescription medications and medical supplies
- Bedding and comfortable clothing including sleeping bags and pillows
- Bottled water, a battery-operated radio and extra batteries, a first aid kit and a flashlight
- Copies of important documents including: driver's license, Social Security card, proof of residence, insurance policies, wills, deeds, birth and marriage certificates, tax records, family photos, etc.

Make sure you have a "to-go bag" ready in case you need to evacuate. Include all of the items above, plus:

- Water and non-perishable food
- Maps (state & local)
- Important documents such as proof of residence, pictures of your family and pets, insurance policies, and tax records.
- Comfortable clothing and blankets
- Unique family needs such as pet supplies, infant supplies or any other unique need your family may have

Refuse bins may be placed at the curbside after **5:00 PM** the evening before your scheduled collection day and must be returned to their proper storage location by **8:00 PM** on collection day. Bulk items, trash receptacles, and building supplies should **NOT** be stored anywhere visible from the street. If you have bulk items and want to learn how to dispose of them at the Bethel Landfill, contact the office at (757) 920-7100.
