WASTE MANAGEMENT & CONTACT INFORMATION

WASTE MANAGEMENT BULK COLLECTION PROCESS

- Please be environmentally conscious and consider item donation before placing out for bulk collection.
- Bulk items must be placed just behind the curb line in front of your home no later than 24 hours prior to service day.
- Do not place in the street, on the sidewalk, or in any fashion that may interrupt normal daily movement.
- Do not place within 3 ft. of an obstructions (mailbox, parked car, fire hydrant, tree, etc.)
- Do not place under low hanging tree limbs or other overhead obstacles.
- Residents also have the option to deliver bulk items directly to WM Bethel Landfill with proper ID.
- Residents may place up to (2) cubic yards of bulk at the curb, per service.
