Maintenance Holiday Reminder

All decorative lighting must be UL or FM approved for either indoor or outdoor use. Outside decorative lights are to be turned off no later than midnight, except on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve, when they are allowed to remain on overnight. Outside lights are not authorized during daylight hours. Holiday decorations and outside lighting are prohibited from being placed higher than the edge of the roof gutter. The use of staples, nails, screws, or other mechanical fasteners to attach decorations or lighting to the homes and associated structures is prohibited. Plastic clip-on hooks may be commercially obtained and used to attach decorative lighting, garlands, etc. Attachment of anything to vinyl siding is prohibited. Additionally, electrical decorations must be unplugged when residents are away from the home.

Going Out of Town for the Holidays?

Langley Family Housing requires that residents provide advance notification when their home will be unoccupied for more than 7 days. We have a form called NOTIFICATION OF ABSENCE FROM THE HOME - we can email it or you can stop by either office to pick one up.

With the holidays upon us, we'd like to take this opportunity to reflect on our gifts - we have a wonderful community of neighbors.
